AS PLANT PATHOLOGY RESEARCHER HE IS ASSOCIATED WITH STELLENBOSCH UNIVERSITY'S PLANT PATHOLOGY DEPARTMENT AS EXTRAORDINARY PROFESSOR. HIS RESEARCH FOCUSES ON FUNGICIDE APPLICATION TECHNOLOGY IN CITRUS ORCHARDS AND PACKHOUSES AND CITRUS BLACK SPOT EPIDEMIOLOGY.
